WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA-PACIFIC UTILITIES COMPANY, by Advice No. 31-E, filed May 1, 1951, having requested authority to make revisions in its tariff schedules effective on thirty days' notice as designated in Rule and Regulation No. 7, set forth on Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 218-E, relating to the amount of deposit required from applicants for service in order to establish credit, and a decrease from 5% to 6% per annum in the interest rate paid on such deposits, which said revisions will result in increases in rates or charges requiring authorization by the Commission; and

It appearing that such increased rates or charges as will result from the above revisions in the schedules of rules and regulations are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,
