SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules or Service
which will Result in an Increase in Rates or Charges.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice No. 101-E filed July 17, 1951, having requested authority effective on 30 days' notice to transfer customers from its tariffs applicable in unincorporated areas to its tariffs applicable within the City of Huron, incorporated May 3, 1951, and

WHEREAS: Such transfer will result in an increase in charges to one customer through transfer from Schedule DA-6, as set forth on Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 1801-E and 2023-E, to Schedule L-4, as set forth on Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 2022-E and 2021-E, and

WHEREAS: It appears that such increased rates or charges are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 63(a) of the Public Utilities Act to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to transfer said customer from schedule DA-6 to Schedule L-4, effective with bills for regular billing periods ending on or after August 18, 1951.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company's Advice No. 101-E shall be marked to show that this authority has been granted under Resolution No. E-758 of the Public Utilities Act of the State of California.
