R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Agreement Filed Under Section X,
Paragraph A of General Order No. 96.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY has submitted for filing a letter agreement under date of March 5, 1951 for the rendering of electric service to Pacific Gas and Electric Company at rates and conditions which differ from Edison's filed tariffs, authorization by the Commission under Section 17(b) of the Public Utilities Act being required, and it appearing that authorization of said agreement is justified and good cause appearing, therefore

IT IS ORDERED that Southern California Edison Company be authorized under Section 17(b) of the Public Utilities Act to carry out the terms and conditions of said agreement and to render the utility service and charge the rates in accordance with said agreement.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the agreement hereinbefore authorized shall be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution No. E-759 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
