SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules Which  
May Result in an Increase in Rates or Charges.

WHEREAS: INDIAN VALLEY LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY by Advice No. 24,  
filed August 6, 1951 having requested authority to make revisions in  
its tariff schedule effective on thirty (30) days' notice, as designated  
in Schedule C-1, set forth on Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 136-E  
relating to the minimum charge which revision may result in an increase  
in charges requiring authorization by the Commission.
