**RETURN TO ELECTRIC DIVISION**

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Letter Agreement Under Section X, Paragraph A of General Order No. 96.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having submitted for filing and having requested authorization for a letter agreement with the Central Valley Street Lighting Association, dated September 12, 1951, which letter agreement modifies a contract between the Association and the Company dated January 17, 1950 and authorized by this Commission's Resolution No. E-712, and

WHEREAS: Said modification of September 12, 1951 provides for service to 16 - 2500 lumen lamps, effective October 1, 1951, in place of 5 - 2500 lumen and 11 - 4000 lumen lamps as provided in the original contract of January 17, 1950, at the rate authorized by Resolution No. E-712 for such 2500 lumen lamps, and the Commission being of the opinion that such authorization should be granted, therefore,


IT IS ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company be authorized under Section 17(b) of the Public Utilities Act to carry out the provisions of said letter agreement in accordance with the terms thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the letter agreement hereinbefore authorized be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution No. E-766 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.

The Secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this resolution to be mailed to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company
