SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revisions in Tariff Schedules on Less than Statutory Notice and Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules which may Result in an Increase in Rates or Charges.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice No. 102-E, filed October 25, 1951, having requested authority under Section 15 of the Public Utilities Act to make revisions in its electric tariff schedules as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 2024-E to 2030-E, inclusive, relating to Preliminary Statement and Table of Contents, effective on less than thirty days' notice, namely on November 1, 1951, and

WHEREAS: The revision of the Preliminary Statement on Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 2028-E may result in an increase in rates and charges through transfer of a portion of the former Special Rate Area (55), Salinas Sub-urban North Area from Zone 5 rates to Zone 6 rates, although there are no electric customers presently located in said portion, and Pacific Gas and Electric Company having requested authority for said transfer under Section 63(a) of the Public Utilities Act; and

It appearing that such increase in rates and charges as may result from the above described revision of Special Rate Area (55) is justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 63(a) of the Public Utilities Act to make the above revision of Special Rate Area (55) effective, and under Section 15 of the Public Utilities Act to make the above sheets effective, both on November 1, 1951.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariff sheets issued in accordance with the order herein contained shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution No. E-768 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
