SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Special Contract Filed Under
Section X, Paragraph A, General Order No. 96.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY has submitted for filing a letter agreement dated November 7, 1951, with San Diego Gas and Electric Company, known as the "Capistrano Standby Agreement", which provides for standby service by Edison to San Diego's Capistrano Substation under rates and conditions which differ from Edison's filed tariffs, authorization by the Commission under Section 532 of Division 1 of the Public Utilities Code being required, it appearing that authorization of said Capistrano Standby Agreement is justified, and good cause appearing, therefore,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be and it hereby is granted to Southern California Edison Company under Section 532 of Division 1 of the Public Utilities Code to render the utility service under the conditions and in accordance with the terms of said letter agreement dated November 7, 1951.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said agreement shall be marked to show that such authorization was granted under Resolution No. E-772 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given said utility of the granting of this authorization.
