RETURN TO ELECTRIC DIVISION

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules
Which Will Result in Increased Rates or Charges.

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA-PACIFIC UTILITIES COMPANY, by Advice No. 34-E, filed January 10, 1952, having requested authority to make revisions in its tariff schedules effective on thirty days' notice as designated in Rule and Regulation No. 5, set forth on Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 229-E, changing the interest rate to be paid on deposits for establishment of credit, from 6% to 5% per annum, to agree with the interest rate quoted in Rule and Regulation No. 7 and approved by Commission Resolution No. E-754, which said revision will result in a technical increase in rates or charges requiring authorization by the Commission; and

It appearing that such increased rates or charges as will result from the above revisions in Rule and Regulation No. 5 are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of Division 1 of the Public Utilities Code to make the Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 229-E, effective on statutory notice, namely, on February 9, 1952.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariff sheet issued in accordance with the order herein contained shall be marked to show that such sheet was issued under Resolution No. E-774 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
