SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare
with Class "H" Lines.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested, by letter of February 19, 1952, permission to occupy both sides of Pacific Avenue between Albee and Broadway in the City of Eureka with Class "H" lines for a distance of about 420 feet, and The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has stated that it has no objection to this proposed construction, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission such occupancy constitutes a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: Pacific presently occupies the north side of Pacific Avenue with a 12 kv and a 2.4 kv circuit and proposes to construct a 60 kv pole line on the south side of Pacific Avenue.

IT IS FOUND that the requested permission should be granted, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be and it hereby is granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy both sides of Pacific Avenue between Albee and Broadway in the City of Eureka for a distance of approximately 420 feet, substantially in accordance with the sketch included with its letter of February 19, 1952.

However, future telephone demands on this street may necessitate joint construction on the north side of Pacific Avenue and it is required that the Pacific Gas and Electric Company will cooperate in effecting such reconstruction as may be necessary equitably to resolve conflicting requirements.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given said utility of the granting of this authorization.
