SUBJECT: **Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare with Class "N" Lines.**

WHEREAS: **PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY** having requested, by letter of February 19, 1952, permission to occupy both sides of McCall Avenue for a distance of 500 feet south of Ashland Avenue some 10½ miles north and east of Fresno, Fresno County, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission such occupancy constitutes a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company states that no measures of coordination will be required in this instance, and

WHEREAS: Pacific presently occupies the east side of McCall Avenue with a 110 kv circuit and proposes to construct a 12 kv circuit on the west side of McCall Avenue, and since the building of the 12 kv circuit under the 110 kv circuit would not permit the required ground clearance,

IT IS FOUND that the requested permission should be granted, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be and it is hereby granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy both sides of McCall Avenue for a distance of 500 feet south of Ashland Avenue, some 10½ miles north and east of Fresno, Fresno County, substantially in accordance with the sketch included in its letter of February 19, 1952.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given said utility of the granting of this authorization.
