WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested, by letter of February 20, 1952, permission to occupy both sides of Highway No. 99 with Class "H" lines for a distance of about 548 feet, at Lebec, approximately 45 miles south of Bakersfield in Kern County, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission such occupancy constitutes a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company is in accordance with this construction, and

WHEREAS: Pacific proposes to construct a 12 kv line on the west side of the highway in order to serve the customers on this side of the highway without extending service drops across Highway No. 99, which has a width of 230 feet.

IT IS FOUND that the requested permission should be granted, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEXCEY ORDERED that permission be and it is hereby granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy both sides of Highway No. 99 at Lebec, approximately 45 miles south of Bakersfield, Kern County, for a distance of about 548 feet, substantially in accordance with the sketch included with its letter of February 20, 1952.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given said utility of the granting of this authorization.
