WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice No. 104-E, filed February 21, 1952, having requested authority effective on a thirty days' notice to transfer from its tariffs applicable for the City of Walnut Creek to its tariffs applicable to the unincorporated areas those customers in the area removed from within the corporate limits of Walnut Creek on December 24, 1951 by Ordinance No. 186.

WHEREAS: it appears that such increased rates or charges are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HERSEY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company to transfer said customers from rates applicable to the City of Walnut Creek to those applicable in unincorporated areas effective with bills for regular billing periods on or after March 22, 1952.
