SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare
with Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested, by letter of March 11, 1952, permission to occupy both sides of Road 26E west of its intersection with road 24N for a distance of 2,608 feet, approximately 15 miles northwest of the City of Madera, Madera County, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission such occupancy constitutes a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order 95, and

WHEREAS: Pacific proposes to construct a 12 kv circuit on the north side of the road since it is not possible to under build a 110 kv circuit on the south side of the road and still maintain the required ground clearances.


IT IS FOUND that the required permission should be granted, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be and it is hereby granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy both sides of Road 26E west of its intersection with Road 24N for a distance of 2,608 feet, approximately 15 miles northwest of the City of Madera, Madera County, substantially in accordance with the sketch included in its letter of March 11, 1952.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given said utility of the granting of this authorization.
