SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy both Sides of Thoroughfare with Class "H" Lines.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested by letter of August 21, 1952, permission to occupy the south side of Second Street for approximately 140 feet westerly of Lindero Street in San Rafael, Marin County, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission such occupancy constitutes a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has expressed its accord with the proposed construction, and

WHEREAS: With the expansion of this company's san Rafael substation it is desired to relocate the 12 kv bus structure and outgoing lines in order to obtain additional space in the substation yard,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be and it is hereby granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" lines both sides of Second Street, substantially in accordance with the sketch included in its letter of August 21, 1952.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
