SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare with Class "H" Lines.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested by letter of October 2, 1952 permission to occupy with Class "H" lines both sides of Del Rey Avenue, about 1,797 feet north of Belmont Avenue, 10½ miles east of Fresno, Fresno County, for a distance of approximately 550 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy constitutes a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and


WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has expressed its accord with the proposed construction, and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be and it is hereby granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" lines both sides of Del Rey Avenue, Fresno County, for a distance of approximately 550 feet, substantially in accordance with the sketch included in its letter of October 2, 1952.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
