SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Special Agreement Under Section X, Paragraph A of General Order No. 96.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY having submitted for filing and having requested authorization for, an agreement with The Los Angeles Transit lines dated August 26, 1952, which agreement provides for electric service to the Transit Lines on and after September 1, 1952 on a month-by-month basis, terminable on 30 days' notice given by either party to the other, under rates and/or conditions which differ from the filed tariffs of Southern California Edison Company, and the Commission being of the opinion that such authorization should be granted, therefore,
