R E S O L U T I O N

RETURN TO ELECTRIC SECTION

SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare with Class "H" Lines.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested by letter of December 15, 1952 permission to occupy with Class "H" lines both sides of Highway 466, at Wasco, Kern County, westerly from the Wasco Substation approximately 579 feet to the Central Valley Highway, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has expressed its accord with the proposed construction,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" lines both sides of Highway 466, at Wasco, Kern County, westerly from the Wasco Substation approximately 579 feet to the Central Valley Highway, substantially in accordance with the sketch included in its letter of December 15, 1952.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
