SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedule Which May Result in Increased Rates or Charges.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice No. 113-E, filed March 9, 1953, having requested authority to make revisions in its tariff schedules effective on thirty (30) days' notice as designated in Schedule R, Resale Service, set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 2200-E, which revisions may be considered to impose more restrictive conditions requiring authorization by the Commission; and

It appearing that such increased rates or charges as may result from the above revisions are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above described sheet effective on statutory notice, namely April 8, 1953.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that said tariff sheet issued in accordance with the order herein contained shall be marked to show that such sheet was issued under Resolution No. E-801 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
