SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules
Which Will Result in Increased Rates or Charges.

WHEREAS: THE CALIFORNIA OREGON POWER COMPANY, by Advice No. 79, filed on May 8, 1953, having requested authority to make revisions in its tariff schedules effective on thirty days' notice as designated in Rule and Regulation Nos. 5 and 8, set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 424-E and 425-E, respectively, changing the interest rate to be paid on deposits for establishment of credit, from 6% to 5% per annum, which said revision will result in a technical increase in rates or charges requiring authorization by the Commission; and

It appearing that such increased rates or charges as will result from the above revisions in Rule and Regulation Nos. 5 and 8 are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 424-E and 425-E, effective on statutory notice, namely, on June 7, 1953.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariff sheets issued in accordance with the order herein contained shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution No. E-807 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
