SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare  
With Class "H" Lines.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested, by letter of June 8, 1953, permission to occupy with Class "H" lines both sides of Colgan Avenue from Petaluma Hill Road to Highway 101, Sonoma County, a distance of approximately 1,610 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter expressed its accord with the proposed construction,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" lines both sides of Colgan Avenue from Petaluma Hill Road to Highway 101, Sonoma County, approximately 1,610 feet, substantially in accordance with the sketch included in its letter of June 8, 1953. It is expected that the parties involved will cooperate with respect to the coordination of the protective equipment on both power and communication circuits to minimize the effect of accidental contact.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
