SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules Which Will Result in Increased Rates or Charges.

WHEREAS: COAST COUNTIES GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice No. 102-E, filed on July 29, 1953, having requested authority to make revisions in its tariff schedules effective on thirty days' notice as designated in Rule and Regulation No. 2, set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 507-E to 509-E, inclusive, to include provisions with respect to wind machines for frost prevention, which said revisions will result in an increase in rates or charges, and

It appearing that such increased rates or charges as will result from the above revisions in Rule and Regulation No. 2 are justified; therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 507-E to 509-E, inclusive, effective on statutory notice, namely, on August 28, 1953.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariff sheets issued in accordance with the order herein contained shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution No. E-813 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
