SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare  
With Class "H" Lines.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, having requested, by letter of July 26, 1953, permission to occupy with Class "H" lines both sides of California State Highway Route No. 58K (McKittrick Highway) beginning at a point 4,773 feet east of Wasco Way and extending easterly for a distance of approximately 4,458 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Kern Mutual Telephone Company has by letter expressed its accord with the proposed construction,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" lines both sides of California State Highway Route No. 58K beginning at a point approximately 4,773 feet east of Wasco Way and extending easterly for a distance of approximately 4,458 feet substantially in accordance with the sketch included in its letter of July 28, 1953.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company and the Kern Mutual Telephone Company of the granting of this authorization.
