SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules which will Result in Increased Rates or Charges.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice No. 117-E, filed on July 28, 1953, having requested authority to make revisions in its tariff schedules effective on thirty days' notice as designated in Rule and Regulation No. 15, set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 2216-E and 2217-E, to include building lines on public lands under the same conditions that it presently builds lines on private property, increase the excess footage charge and increase the refund rate per foot of free length, which said revisions will result in an increase in rates or charges, and

IT IS HEREBY FOUND that such increased rates or charges as will result from the above revisions in Rule and Regulation No. 15 are justified,

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 2216-E and 2217-E, effective on statutory notice, namely, on August 27, 1953.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall apply the provisions of Sections C-1, and E-3 of its present extension rule as shown on Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 1403-E and 1404-E in the arrangements for construction of extensions to those prospective customers who, in good faith, have filed applications or negotiated for service prior to August 27, 1953, provided the prospective customers advance the required amount under said provisions on or before February 27, 1954. Pacific Gas and Electric Company is directed to notify, on or before September 26, 1953, each of those prospective customers who have filed applications, or who have negotiated for service since February 27, 1953, and who would be required to deposit with the company an advance in aid of construction under Section C-1 of its electric extension rule that the advance will be computed at the rate of 60 cents per foot of excess length of line unless the deposit computed on the prior basis has been made with the company on or before February 27, 1954.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariff sheets issued in accordance with the order herein contained shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution No. E-816 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
