SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare  
With Class "H" Lines.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, having requested, by letter of July 28, 1953, permission to occupy with a Class "H" line the easterly side of Alabama Road near Galt in Sacramento County for a distance of 9,600 feet, and

WHEREAS: The Sacramento Municipal Utility District now occupies the westerly side of Alabama Road, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Sacramento Municipal Utility District and The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company have both by letter expressed accord with the proposed construction.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with a Class "H" line the easterly side of Alabama Road in Sacramento County beginning at the northerly side of Simmerhorn Road and extending northerly a distance of 5,030 feet and also extending 1,500 feet northerly and 3,070 feet southerly from the southerly side of Borden Road, substantially in accordance with the sketch included in its letter of July 26, 1953.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company. The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company and Sacramento Municipal Utility District of the granting of this authorization.
