IT IS HERREY ORDERED that Jones Decorating Company of Los Angeles is authorized to install and maintain temporary decorative garlands, lighting and other decorative fixtures on electric trolley facilities along Brand Boulevard, Glendsle, in accordance with Rule 78.3-C of General Order No. 95, and substantially as shown on the drawing attached to its letter of request dated August 28, 1953. This authorization shall terminate on January 10, 1954, and shall not be construed as permitting any use of utility facilities for such temporary construction without the consent of all parties having ownership in the poles or facilities to which attachment may be made.
