WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, having requested by letter of August 20, 1953, permission to occupy with Class "H" lines both sides of California State Highway Route No. 128, about 1-1/2 miles east of Butherford, beginning at the intersection of Butherford Lene and Comm Creek Road and extending northerly for a distance of approximately 1,125 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission such occupancy would constitute a violation of Eule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter expressed its accord with the proposed construction,

IT IS HERREY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" lines both sides of California State Highway Route No. 128, about 1-1/2 miles east of Rutherford, beginning at the intersection of Butherford Lane and Conn Creek Road and extending northerly for a distance of approximately 1,125 feet, substantially in accordance with the sketch included in its letter of August 20, 1953.
