SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare
With Class "H" Lines.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, having requested by letter of August 20, 1953, permission to occupy with Class "H" lines both sides of California State Highway Route No. 128, about 1-1/2 miles east of Rutherford, beginning at the intersection of Rutherford Lane and Conn Creek Road and extending northerly for a distance of approximately 1,125 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission such occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter expressed its accord with the proposed construction,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" lines both sides of California State Highway Route No. 128, about 1-1/2 miles east of Rutherford, beginning at the intersection of Rutherford Lane and Conn Creek Road and extending northerly for a distance of approximately 1,125 feet, substantially in accordance with the sketch included in its letter of August 20, 1953.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company and The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company of the granting of this authorization.
