SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare with
Class "H" Lines.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, having requested by
letter of October 19, 1953, permission to occupy with Class "H" lines
both sides of Highway 99 near Redding, Shasta County for a distance of
approximately 1,290 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would
constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95 and,

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter
expressed its accord with the proposed construction,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and
Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" lines both sides of Highway 99
north of Redding from the intersection of the new freeway with the Old
Highway 99 to Redding north for approximately 1,290 feet substantially
in accordance with the sketch included in its letter of October 19, 1953.
It is expected that the parties involved will cooperate with respect to
the coordination of the protective equipment on both power and communica-
tion circuits to minimize the effect of accidental contact.

The Secretary is directed to cause appropriate notice to be
given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this author-
ization.
