SUBJECT: Permission to Support Temporary Decorative Equipment  
above Electric Trolley Facilities

WHEREAS: JONES DECORATING COMPANY of 2807 Sunset Boulevard, Los Angeles, having by letter of October 19, 1953, requested permission to install decorative fixtures on and above electric trolley facilities along Vermont Avenue between 82d and 89th Streets in Los Angeles, during the coming Christmas season, and

WHEREAS: It is found that the requested permission should be granted, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Jones Decorating Company of Los Angeles is authorized to install and maintain temporary decorative garlands, lighting and other decorative fixtures on and above electric trolley facilities along Vermont Avenue between 82d and 89th Streets in Los Angeles, in accordance with Rule 78.3-C of General Order No. 95, and substantially as shown on Sketch B attached to its request of October 19, 1953. This authorization shall terminate on January 11, 1954 and shall not be construed as permitting any use of utility facilities for such temporary construction without the consent of all parties having ownership in the poles or facilities to which attachment may be made.

The Secretary is directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Jones Decorating Company of the granting of this authorization.
