WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having submitted for filing and having requested authorization for a supplemental agreement with Hercules Powder Company dated June 8, 1953 which agreement modifies a contract between Hercules and Pacific dated July 12, 1951 and authorized by this Commission's Decision No. 46947.

WHEREAS: Such modification of June 8, 1953 provides for an increase in the monthly substation rental charge from 1.0775% to 1.1925% of the actual cost of facilities installed subsequent to April 21, 1952. The remaining provisions set forth in said contract dated July 12, 1951 as amended by agreements dated April 11, 1952, June 5, 1952 and November 20, 1952 are to continue in full force and effect. The Commission being of the opinion that such authorization should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company be authorized under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the provisions of said supplemental agreement in accordance with the terms thereof.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the agreement hereinbefore authorized be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution No. E-825 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.

The Secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this resolution to be mailed to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company. A certified copy of this resolution shall be filed as a matter of record in Application No. 32750.
