SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare with Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY, having requested by letters of October 7, and November 25, 1953 permission to occupy the north side of Second Street from Allen Street to Arrowhead Avenue in the City of San Bernardino with a 34.5 kv, Class "H" line, the south side of Second Street being occupied by a Class "H" line belonging to the Southern California Edison Company, and

WHEREAS: General Telephone Company has by letter expressed its accord with the proposed construction and has indicated that necessary easements have been obtained to allow for the relocation of existing telephone facilities, and California Electric Power Company having stated it will pay for said relocation,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted California Electric Power Company to occupy the north side of Second Street from Allen Street west to Arrowhead Avenue in the City of San Bernardino, California, substantially in accordance with Sheet No. 6 of Drawing D33-507 included in its letter of October 7, 1953.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the California Electric Power Company and the General Telephone Company of the granting of this authorization.
