WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, having requested by letter of December 7, 1953, permission to occupy the north side of Sonoma Avenue in and outside of the city limits of Santa Rosa between Brookwood Avenue and Shortt Road for a distance of 3,600 feet, the southerly side of Sonoma Avenue being now occupied by a Class "H" line belonging to the same company, and,

WHENEAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, has by letter of November 13, 1953, to the Pacific Gas and Alectric Company, expressed its accord with the proposed construction and stated that it meets with its approval, and

WHEREAS: The staff of the Commission's Electric Section Safety Unit has viewed the area of the proposed construction in the field and believes the proposed construction to be in accordance with good practice,

IT IS HEREET ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy both sides of Sonoma Avenue in and outside of the city limits of Santa Rosa for a distance of 3,600 feet between Brookwood Avenue and Shortt Road in Sonoma County, California, substantially in accordance with Drawing No. LE 99025 included with its letter of December 7, 1953.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
