SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revisions in Tariff Schedules Which May Result in an Increase in Rates and Authorizing Cancellation of a Rate Schedule.

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA-PACIFIC UTILITIES COMPANY, by its Advice No. 36-E, filed December 10, 1953, and Supplement Advice No. 36-E, filed December 23, 1953, having requested authority to make revisions in its tariff schedules as designated in:

WHEREAS: Said revisions and withdrawal may result in an increase in rates or charges requiring authorization by the Commission under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code.


IT IS FOUND that such increased rates or charges as may result from the above revisions and withdrawal in the schedule of rates are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,
