SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare
with Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, having requested by letter of December 28, 1953 permission to occupy both sides of Ellis Street, Santa Rosa, Sonoma County, with Class "H" circuits for a distance of 590 feet between its Santa Rosa substation "A" and South A Street, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter of December 11, 1953 to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company expressed its approval of the proposed construction and stated that all joint use details have been agreed upon, and

WHEREAS: The location of the proposed Class "H" circuit has been viewed in the field by a member of the Electric Section, Safety Unit staff who reports the proposed construction to be within good practice,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy both sides of Ellis Street, Santa Rosa, Sonoma County, with Class "H" circuits for a distance of 590 feet between substation A and South A Street substantially in accordance with Drawing No. G.M.C. 124350 included with its letter of December 28, 1953.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
