SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare with  
Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested by  
letter of December 15, 1953, permission to occupy the west side of  
McCall Avenue in Fresno County for a distance of 1,848 feet north of  
East Tulare Avenue, the east side of McCall Avenue being now occupied  
by a Class "H" line belonging to the same company, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter  
of December 7, 1953 to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company expressed  
its accord with the proposed construction and stated that it meets  
with its approval, and

WHEREAS: A staff engineer of the Commission's Electric Section  
Safety Unit has reviewed the proposed extension route in the field and  
believes the proposed construction to be in accordance with good  
practice,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and  
Electric Company to occupy both sides of McCall Avenue in Fresno  
County north from East Tulare Avenue for a distance of 1,848 feet sub-  
stantially in accordance with the sketch submitted with its letter of  
December 15, 1953.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice  
to be given to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of  
this authorization.
