SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare with
Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested by letter of January 25, 1954 permission to occupy both sides of Welty Road, southeast of Tracy, Stanislaus County with Class "H" circuits for a distance of 984 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter of January 15, 1954 to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company stated it has no objection to the proposed construction.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy both sides of Welty Road (also known and referred to as McCracken Road) Stanislaus County, with Class "H" lines for a distance of 984 feet, extending southerly from Romain Road, substantially as shown on drawing number A-535 STOCKTON submitted with its letter of January 25, 1954.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
