SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare with
Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested by letter of February 11, 1954, permission to occupy both sides of Lawrence Road, Sunnyvale, Santa Clara County, with Class "H" circuits for a distance of 2,900 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter of January 20, 1954 to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company stated that it has agreed with the plan of the proposed construction with the Pacific Gas and Electric Company.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy both sides of Lawrence Road, Sunnyvale, Santa Clara County, with Class "H" lines between Arques Road and Agnew Road a distance of 2,900 feet, more or less, and substantially as shown on the plan marked Est. No. 33794 attached to its letter of February 11, 1954.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
