> SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare with Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested by letter of February 16, 1954 permission to continue to occupy both sides of Eleventh Avenue near Manford with Class "H" lines for a distance of 12,190 feet. and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter of January 28, 1954 to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company confirmed an agreement between the two companies for such occupancy.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to continue to occupy both sides of Eleventh Avenue near Hanford, Kings County, with Class "H" lines for 12,190 feet, more or less, from Idaho Avenue to a point of meeting with the section of the occupancy authorized and described in Resolution No. E-769, and substantially as shown on the plan map submitted with its letter of February 16, 1954.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
