SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Letter Agreement Filed Under Section X, Paragraph A, of General Order No. 96, which will Result in Increased Charges

WHEREAS: THE CALIFORNIA OREGON POWER COMPANY, having submitted for filing an agreement with The Long-Bell Lumber Company dated March 1, 1954, which amends an existing agreement dated August 24, 1931 for furnishing utility service to said company near the City of Weed in Siskiyou County under rates that differ from the utility's filed tariff schedules and authorization by the Commission under Sections 454 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code being required, and it appearing that authorization of the aforesaid modification is justified, and good cause appearing,

IT IS FOUND that such increased rates or charges as will result are justified, and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The California Oregon Power Company be authorized under Sections 454 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to extend the utility service under the conditions and in accordance with the terms of said agreement.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the agreement hereinbefore authorized be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution No. E-839 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
