SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare
with Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested, by letters of April 9, 1953 and March 22, 1954, permission to occupy both sides of Stony Point Road, east of Meacham Road, Sonoma County, with Class "H" lines for a distance of 1,203 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter of February 5, 1954 to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company stated the proposed construction meets with its approval and all joint use details have been agreed upon.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy both sides of Stony Point Road with Class "H" lines from its intersection with Meacham Road to a point 1,203 feet easterly, more or less, to its Cotati substation, Sonoma County.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
