WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter of February 5, 1954 to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company stated the proposed construction meets with its approval and all joint use details have been agreed upon.

IT IS HERREY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy both sides of Stony Point Road with Class "H" lines from its intersection with Meacham Road to a point 1,203 feet easterly, more or less, to its Cotati substation, Sonoma County.
