SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfares  
with Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested by letter of March 29, 1954 permission to occupy both sides of Fresno Avenue, 2 miles northwest of Shafter, Kern County, with Class "H" circuits for a distance of 1,103 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and


WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter of March 22, 1954 to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company stated it concurs with the proposed plan.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy both sides of Fresno Avenue, near Shafter, Kern County, from its Shafter substation to Scaroni Avenue, a distance of 1,103 feet, more or less, and substantially as shown in the plan map made a part of its letter of March 29, 1954.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
