SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare with Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested by letter of April 13, 1954, permission to occupy both sides of McCracken Road, southeast of Tracy, Stanislaus County with Class "H" circuits for a distance of 1,659 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter of April 2, 1954 to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company stated that it has no objection to the proposed construction.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy both sides of McCracken Road, Stanislaus County, with Class "H" circuits for a distance of 1,659 feet more or less, extending southerly from Gaffery Road, and substantially as shown on the plan drawing marked A-549/Stockton submitted with its letter of April 2, 1954.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
