SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare with Class "H" Lines.

PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested by latter of May 12, 1954, permission to occupy both sides of Highway No. 1, north of the community of Half Moon Bay, San Mateo County, with Class "H" circuits for a distance of 2,640 feet, and

'WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

MHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter of April 23, 1954 to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company stated that it concurs with the proposed occupancy of both sides of the thoroughfare,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy both sides of State Highway Mo. 1, north of, and near, the community of Half Moon Bay, Ban Mateo County, with Class "H" circuits for a total distance of 2,640 feet more or less, substantially as shown on the plan map marked Est. 84306-86676 submitted with its letter of May 12, 1954.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
