SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare with Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, having requested by letter of June 15, 1954, permission to occupy both sides of Grant Road in Los Altos, Santa Clara County, with Class "H" circuits for a distance of approximately 5,920 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter of June 1, 1954 to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company expressed approval of the proposed occupancy of both sides of the thoroughfare,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Grant Road in Los Altos, Santa Clara County, from Fremont Road to Mountain View-Stevens Creek Road, a distance of approximately 5,920 feet. The construction to be substantially the same as shown on the plan map submitted with its request of June 15, 1954.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
