SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare with Class "N" Lines.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, having requested by letter of June 28, 1954, permission to continue to occupy both sides of Manila Avenue in El Cerrito with Class "N" circuits for a distance of approximately 465 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy constitutes a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter of May 6, 1954, expressed approval of the continued occupancy of both sides of the thoroughfare,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "N" circuits both sides of Manila Avenue in El Cerrito, between Everett Street and Elm Street, a distance of approximately 465 feet.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
