SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfares with Class "H" Lines.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested by letter of July 28, 1954, permission to occupy with Class "H" lines both sides of portions of Bubb Road and Prospect Road near Cupertino, Santa Clara County, for approximately 9,040 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter of July 16, 1954 expressed approval of the proposed occupancy of both sides of the subject thoroughfares,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Bubb Road westerly from Stelling Road for a distance of approximately 4,255 feet and Prospect Road for a distance of 2,180 feet east of and 2,605 feet west of Saratoga-Sunnyvale Road. The construction to be substantially the same as shown on the plan map submitted with its request of July 28, 1954.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
