SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare
with Class "H" Circuits

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, having requested by letter of September 23, 1954, permission to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Harris Street in Eureka for a distance of 835 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter of September 4, 1954 expressed approval of the proposed occupancy of both sides of the subject thoroughfare,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy both sides of Harris Street between Central Avenue and Spring Street, Eureka with Class "H" circuits for a distance of 835 feet, more or less, and substantially as shown on the plan map marked GMO 125770 submitted with its request of September 23, 1954.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
