SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deviation from Rule and Regulation No. 15, "Electric Extensions"

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA-PACIFIC UTILITIES COMPANY, by letter of December 1, 1954, having requested a special ruling of this Commission to allow said utility to deviate from its filed Rule and Regulation No. 15, "Electric Extensions", Sections A and B, and

WHEREAS: Said deviation would permit the utility to require an advance in aid of construction from its customer California State Highway Department in the amount of \$6,611.66 being equivalent to the estimated cost of constructing a line extension at an average cost of $57\frac{1}{2}$ ¢ per foot, instead of an advance of \$2,876 being at the rate of 25¢ per foot as provided for in its Nule and Regulation No. 15; and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ONDERED that authority be granted California-Pacific Utilities Company to deviate from its filed Rule and Regulation No. 15, Sections A and B, in the manner and only to the extent requested in the utility's letter of December 1, 1954.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that said utility shall file with the Commission copies of any agreements entered into relating to said deviation.
