SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revision in Tariff Schedules on  
Less Than Statutory Notice.

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice No. 152-E, filed  
January 19, 1955, having requested a revision in its tariff schedules as designated  
on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 986-E to 989-E, inclusive, to become effective for  
billings on and after January 31, 1955, which is less than thirty days' notice,  
and

WHEREAS: Said revisions constitute a decrease in rates effected through  
the operation of the fuel oil clause in such tariff schedules; and good cause  
appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the  
Public Utilities Code to make the above-mentioned tariff sheets effective for  
billings on and after January 31, 1955.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that said tariff sheets shall be marked to  
show that such sheets were authorized under Resolution No. 5-874 of the Public  
Utilities Commission of the State of California.
